

Club and Activities List

Art Club - Grades 1-4 Ms. Redican

Students can tap into their creativity to make crafts with their friends. First and Second grade meet from 3:30-4:30 after school on the first Thursday of each month. Third and Fourth grade meet from 3:30-4:30 after school on the third Thursday of each month.

A. V. Club - Grades 5-8 Mrs. Martello

The A.V. Club meets on E Days during Study and is responsible for producing the monthly Student News. Members serve as anchors and reporters, conducting interviews, filming, editing, writing, and creating content to share with the school community.

Book Club - Grades 3-4 Miss. Callahan

Students in grades 3 and 4 are invited to join the Book Club, which meets every E Day during lunch in Miss Callahan's room. Members will read and discuss a selected book, participate in related activities, and build reading and comprehension skills.

Teams meet regularly to discuss the books, share ideas, and prepare for the event. The goal of the program is to promote a love of reading, teamwork, and comprehension skills.
